



 - HR (database and system migrations only)




LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICES BUREAU

- State Social Security Administration



- Administered Local Government CRF Reimbursement Program
- Implemented SABHRS system changes to generate CRF payments
- Enhanced enterprise systems Financials, IBARS, and eMACS
- Carried out 2019 session law changes
 - SB2 Simplified local government reporting
 - SB302 Criteria for legal claims against entities for reporting non-compliance
- Provided training, technical assistance, and collaboration forums

- Prepared statewide financial reports:
 - CAFR Comprehensive Annual Financial Report
 - PAFR Popular Annual Financial Report
 - SWCAP Statewide Cost Allocation Plan
- Implemented ServiceNow help desk, forms, policies, knowledge base
- Designed and adopted EFT fraud mitigation strategies
- Developed agency procurement review program

STATISTICS



- Reviewed 1,900 local government audits and financial reports
- Registered 2,900 new vendors in eMACS
- Issued over 400 solicitations and contracts
- Deposited \$2.5 million in procurement and fuel card rebates
- Paid over 525,000 businesses and individuals
- Processed 3.6 million financial transactions and \$25 billion cash transactions


